PRECAUTIONARY *** BOIL WATER NOTICE ***

Date: **July 1, 2026**

Due to a water main repair on Meadow Hill Road near Patton Road, The Town has issued a Precautionary Boil Water Notice for the **Meadow Hill North Area**. The following areas are affected by this notice:

Meadow Hill Road, north of Lancer Drive to Patton Road.

Monarch Drive, from Meadow Hill Road to Patton Road.

Patton Road, from Monarch to Meadow Hill Road.

Possibly parts of Queens Way and Crown Boulevard.

We recommend that all water used from this supply be rapidly boiled for at least one (1) minute prior to use for either drinking or food preparation purposes. Another alternative is to use bottled water, certified for sale by the New York State Department of Health.

You should continue this practice until you receive notification from the Town of Newburgh Water Department.

Harmful microbes in drinking water can cause diarrhea, cramps, nausea, headaches, or other symptoms and may pose a special health risk for infants, some elderly, and people with severely compromised immune systems. But these symptoms are not just caused by microbes in drinking water. If you experience any of these symptoms and they persist, you should seek medical advice.
