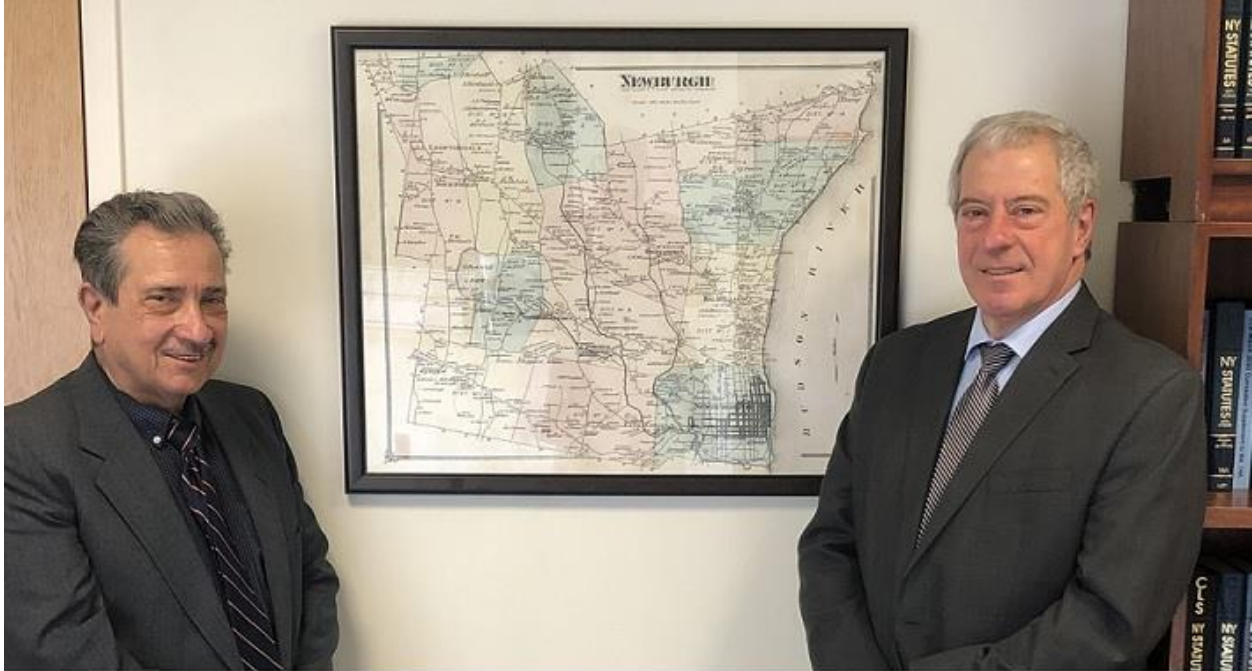


TOWN OF NEWBURGH RECEIVES GIFT

District six: Middlehope

District seven: East Coldenham

District eight: Union Grove

District nine: Leptondale
