Villacci Enclosed for the Town Board's consideration please find the following draft resolutions regarding the proposed Local Law which reestablishes a temporary permit system for outdoor dining during 2022 in order to assist local businesses in recovery from the effects of the pandemic emergency.

**DINING PERMITS DURING THE YEAR 2022** 

- RESOLUTION OF SEQR DESIGNATION AND DETERMINATION: ADOPTION OF PROPOSED LOCAL LAW PROVIDING FOR TEMPORARY OUTDOOR DINING PERMITS DURING THE YEAR 2022 (with the proposed Negative Declaration); and
- 2. RESOLUTION OF ADOPTION OF LOCAL LAW PROVIDING FOR TEMPORARY OUTDOOR DINING PERMITS DURING THE YEAR 2022.

The Local Law allows only temporary seating and fixtures and provides: "[n]o permanent improvements shall be made without appropriate approvals," which would generally require an amended site plan approval. I'm informed a couple of establishments reportedly installed permanent improvements during 2021 in violation.

RESOLUTION OF SEQR DESIGNATION AND DETERMINATION: ADOPTION OF A PROPOSED LOCAL LAW PROVIDING FOR TEMPORARY OUTDOOR DINING PERMITS DURING THE YEAR 2022

Councilman/woman \_\_\_\_\_\_ presented the following resolution which was seconded by

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Newburgh has caused to be prepared a local law which will authorize the Town of Newburgh Code Compliance Department to issue temporary outdoor dining permits during the year 2022 to establishments with approved indoor seating for eating and drinking patrons; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Newburgh recognizes the importance of sound planning as a means of promoting responsible development and protecting the health, safety and general welfare of the citizens of the Town of Newburgh and otherwise fulfilling the legislative findings and intent set forth in Town Law Section 272-a and has determined that that the proposed Local Law temporarily superseding Town Code requirements and restrictions does not require an amendment to the Town's Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Newburgh has caused an Environmental Assessment Form (the "EAF") to be prepared for the proposed adoption of said local law allowing temporary outdoor dining in the Town of Newburgh during 2022 without permanent improvements (the "Action"); and

WHEREAS, the proposed local law was introduced before the Town Board on the 9th day of May, 2022, and the Town Board conducted a public hearing held on the 13th day of June, 2022 and heard all interested parties on said proposed local law; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board has determined that the Action is an Unlisted Action under Part 617 of the General Regulations adopted pursuant to Article 8 of the Environmental Conservation Law and Chapter 100 entitled "Environmental Quality Review" of the Town of Newburgh Municipal Code; and WHEREAS, the Town Board proposes to undertake, fund and approve the Action and wishes to assume Lead Agency status in connection with the review of the Action pursuant to the State Environmental Quality Review Act; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board has determined that the Action does not involve a federal agency; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board, using all due diligence, has identified no other involved agencies for the Action; and

WHEREAS, the full Environmental Assessment Form for the Action and other appropriate information were forwarded to the Orange County Department of Planning and the Town of Newburgh Planning Board, together with copies of the proposed local law, in accordance with the requirements of the General Municipal Law and the Town of Newburgh Zoning Code and to the Town of Newburgh Zoning Board of Appeals; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 617.6(b)(1) of Part 617, "[w]hen a single agency is involved, that agency will be the lead agency when it proposes to undertake, fund or approve a Type I or Unlisted action that does not involve another agency"; and

WHEREAS, the Action is consistent with the adopted Town of Newburgh Comprehensive Plan Update and is also consistent with the Orange County Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board has also considered the consistency of the amendment with the needs and goals identified by the April, 2009 *Tri-County Affordable Housing Study*, conducted jointly by Orange, Duchess, and Ulster Counties, and the potential affects of the Action on the Town's ability to meet goals for providing rental and owner occupied affordable housing; and

WHEREAS, recognizing that the impact that an action may have on population patterns or existing community character, with or without a separate impact on the physical environment is a relevant concern in an environmental analysis since the statute includes these concerns as elements of the environment, the Town Board has considered and analyzed information pertaining to those impacts; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board has undertaken further information gathering and these further analyses in recognition that conclusory statements unsupported by empirical or experimental data, scientific authorities or any explanatory information will not suffice as a reasoned elaboration for its determination of environmental significance or non-significance; and WHEREAS, the Town Board has (i) thoroughly reviewed the EAF, and any and all other documents prepared and submitted with respect to this proposed action and its environmental review, and (ii) thoroughly analyzed the potential relevant areas of environmental concern to determine if the proposed action may have a significant adverse impact on the environment, including the criteria identified in 6 NYCRR Section 617.7(c); and

WHEREAS, the Town Board has not identified relevant areas of environmental concern which would lead to a determination that the adoption of the proposed local law may have a • significant adverse effect on the environment either in the short term, long term or cumulatively given the likely consequences, setting, probability of occurrence, duration, irreversibility, geographic scope, magnitude and the number of people affected.

#### NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

- The Town Board determines that it is the single involved agency for the Action and as it is proposing to directly undertake the Action, does further declare itself the Lead Agency for the purpose of conducting a review of this Action.
- 2. The Town Board, acting in its capacity as Lead Agency, does hereby further determine that the Action will not have an adverse environmental impact and, accordingly, does issue a negative declaration.

3. The Town Board accordingly determines that an Environmental Impact Statement will not be prepared.

4.

The Town Board hereby authorizes the Supervisor to execute and file the relevant section of the Environmental Assessment Form and a Negative Declaration with such further amendment and modification as may be required to elaborate the Lead Agency's determination herein, in accordance with the applicable provisions of law and all other appropriate notices and documents to effectuate these resolutions in accordance with the applicable provisions of law.

### **Description of Action:**

The action consists of the adoption of a local law by the Town Board of the Town of Newburgh entitled "A Local Law Providing for Temporary Outdoor Dining Permits During the Year 2022." The Local Law will allow for the controlled utilization of certain outdoor spaces for dining activities, for a limited period of time, to assist business establishments in recovery from the effects of the COVID-19 pandemic emergency and afford options for seating in the event the restrictions related to social distancing and decreasing maximum capacity of indoor spaces are imposed again. The Town Board adopted similar legislation in 2021. The Local Law authorizes the Code Compliance Department to issue a permit to remain in effect for a period which expires; December 31, 2022 or such earlier date as the Code Compliance Supervisor determines warranted by the circumstances to a legally operating restaurant, eating and drinking place, fast food establishment, delicatessen and similar use with approved indoor seating as set forth in the Town of Newburgh Zoning Code, to provide outdoor seating for patrons upon complying with all of the requirements and conditions set forth in the Local Law. Application requirements will include a valid liability insurance certificate and a plan showing where the seating will be provided outdoors and potential seating capacity, not to exceed the maximum permissible indoor capacity. If seating is going to be provided in a designated parking area, the plan must also show vehicular and pedestrian access, internal vehicular circulation and the number of parking spaces available for patrons to demonstrate to the reasonable satisfaction of the Building Inspector, sufficient parking on the site. Seating shall not be proposed for fire lanes or other areas where it

would significantly impede emergency responses or the flow of traffic in the judgment of the Town's Code Compliance Department. The Code Compliance Supervisor may waive the permit application requirement if the establishment has already been permitted to have outdoor seating in 2022 pursuant to previously established protocols under emergency orders. All furniture and fixtures used in conjunction with outdoor dining must be of a temporary nature. No signage shall be permitted to be affixed to any temporary structures. No permanent improvements shall be made without appropriate approvals.

### **Reasons Supporting This Determination:**

The lead agency has considered the action and reviewed the environmental assessment form and other supporting information and documents, including comments it received from the public and any other comments from agencies to which the local law was submitted for comment, including the Town of Newburgh Planning Board and the Orange County Planning Department. The action is an unlisted action.

. The following summarizes the review of impacts:

Land – There are no adverse impacts on land associated with this action. Because the action involves the adoption of a local law and not direct construction or other physical activity, there are no direct impacts on land. Accordingly, only indirect impacts require analysis. The proposed action will not have a significant adverse environmental impact on any unique or unusual land forms. The local law pertains to uses which have already been permitted, allowing the continued, temporary extension of seating outdoors for approved establishments with indoor seating, as was allowing during the Covid-19 health emergency by emergency order. The local law allows only temporary seating outdoor arrangements, permanent improvements are still subject to normal approvals, which generally would entail amended site plan approval by the Planning Board. The Town Board finds that there are no significant unmitigated impacts on land associated with this action.

Surface and Groundwater, Drainage and Flooding – There are no adverse impacts on

drainage, surface or groundwater quality, or flooding associated with this action.

- Air Quality or Resources The action would not create any adverse air quality or resource impacts.
- Wildlife Species and Habitat No adverse direct or indirect effects on threatened or endangered species, non-threatened or non-endangered species or habitat would result with this action.
- Agricultural Lands The action would not create adverse impacts on agriculture or agricultural lands. The local law does not introduce regulations with respect to agricultural uses.
- Visual and Aesthetic Resources No adverse impacts on visual or aesthetic resources in the Town or adjoining areas will result from this action.
- Historic and Archeological Resources There would be no adverse impacts on archeological or historic resources with this action.
- Open Space and Recreation The action would not result in adverse impacts on open space or recreation.
- **Transportation and Traffic** The action would not create any adverse traffic or transportation impacts.
- Energy The action would not create any adverse impacts on energy.
- Noise No adverse impacts on noise levels would result from the action. Outdoor dining activities will be subject to the Town's noise and illumination control regulations.
- Public Health and Safety The action would not create adverse public health and safety impacts.
- Land Use and Community Character There are no significant adverse impacts on land use and community character associated with this action. This action is compatible with the Town's Comprehensive Plan Update, as well as the Orange County Comprehensive Plan.
- Affordable Housing The action would not adversely impact upon affordable or workforce housing.
- Community Services (including Solid Waste) No direct adverse impacts on community

services, solid waste collection, and water/utility consumption would result with this action.

Enclosed are copies of a letter from Cathy Drobny, Esq. of E. Stewart Jones, Hacket Murphy regarding the above referenced proposed settlement, a proposed Consent Order and Judgment and charts showing the approximate claimed refund amounts and the approximate refunds that will be due from the taxing jurisdictions under the proposed settlement of the above referenced real property tax assessment appeal. Also enclosed is a map showing the location of the tax parcel which is the subject of the proceedings which contains a retail store attached to the Juster Associates shopping center on NYS Route 17K.

The settlement includes a discontinuance of the 2020 proceedings and provides for a reduction in assessed value of \$86,323 from \$3,288,500 to \$3,202,177 for 2021. The Consent Order and Judgment specifies that the provisions of RPTL Section 727 apply, holding the Assessed Value at \$3,202,177 for the 2022, 2023 and 2024 assessment rolls, subject to the statutory exceptions.

The chart indicates that the refund liability for the Town (including Highway but not including special districts and the Fire District) will be approximately \$1,344.82 versus claimed refund liability of approximately \$51,295.01. Goodwill Fire District, which has a standing request to be informed of all settlements will have a refund liability of approximately \$508.82. The attorney for the Newburgh Enlarged City School District will also be a signatory on the Consent Order.

Also attached is a proposed resolution which would authorize the Settlement.

Attached please find the proposed Consent Order & Judgment relative to the above-referenced proceedings. There are currently two years pending (2020 and 2021).

The subject parcel is the Target located at 50 Route 17K (Tax Map #97-2-7.21). It is a +/-125,946 sq. ft. building and is owner occupied. The FMV is \$10,980,000 in 2020 and \$11,640,708 in 2021. After review of the per sq. ft. value and similar properties, this settlement was negotiated.

The proposed settlement discontinues the 2020 proceeding and reduces the 2021 assessment of the property to an equalized FMV of \$11,335,140 (AV \$3,202,177). The 2021 assessed value as reduced will be held for 2022, 2023 and 2024 pursuant to RPTL §727, subject to the usual statutory exceptions. After considering the costs of trial-ready appraisals and litigation, we feel that this is a good settlement.

I have attached for your review a copy of the refund liability charts, which show the potential liability versus the proposed settlement refund liability.

We recommend that the Town Board authorize us to enter into this settlement as proposed. Please place this matter on the agenda for the next Newburgh Town Board meeting for approval. Once the Resolution passes, please let me know and I will sign the Order.

On behalf of the Applicant, Scannell Properties, LLC, we are requesting written approval to disturb greater than five (5) acres of land at any one time for the above referenced project. The current project includes disturbing up to sixteen (16) acres in a single phase.

#### **Project Description**

The Applicant, Scannell Properties, LLC, is proposing to develop a ±13.8 acre parcel located along NYS Route 17K in the Town of Newburgh, New York. The project, Newburgh Commerce Center, is a commercial development that consists of single-story mixed-use facility – one 132,000 square foot building, with associated car and trailer parking spaces. The project will require the addition of a left turn lane on NYS Route 17K, which will require a road-way widening and the construction of retaining walls and drainage swales in the right-of-way.

The applicant is applying for a 5-acre waiver to disturb up to 16-acres at any one given time. Construction will consist of a single phase. A minimum of 2 site inspections will be conducted every 7 calendar days by a qualified inspector to ensure the stability and effectiveness of all protective measures and practices during construction for as long as more than 5.0 acres of land remains disturbed.
