### SERVICE AGREEMENT

### ORANGE COUNTY USSSA UMPIRES ASSOCIATION

The following agreement is between the ORANGE COUNTY USSSA UMPIRES ASSOCIATION and the Jown of Memburgh Softball League

This working agreement is for providing 2 officials to officiate softball games for the 2025 season at the rate of #74.06 per game. (#37.00 pc umpire)

GAMES - League schedules and additional league rules shall be provided to the association two (2) weeks prior to the start of the season.

PAYMENT - All teams shall be registered with the UNITED STATES SPECIALTY SPORTS ASSOCIATION for the season. (1530 per team) Payments for scheduled games must be made monthly in advance or acceptable method. ONLY league checks or money orders will be accepted for payment. Checks are to be made payable to the <u>O. C. USSSA</u>. The final season payment with any financial adjustments for games not played, shall be paid withih one (1) week of the final games played.

OFFICIALS - Officials will be certified by the assigning association and will perform as independent contractors.

CANCELLED/RESCHEDULED GAMES - A phone number of a league official who is responsible for the cancellation of games due to weather related conditions shall be provided. This number must be activated with information pertaining to the cancellation one (1) hour prior to schedled game times.

If umpires are not notified of cancellation and show up at game site they shall recieve full payment. If the games are started and then weather/playing conditions cause suspension of the game, the umpires will recieve full payment. If an umpire works alone he shall be compensated by payment of 150 0/0 of fee. RESCHEDULED GAMES must be coordinated with the officials association assigner.

TERMINATION - This agreement may be terminated by mutual consent of the league and the officials association. This only applies to future game assignments; it would not apply to payment due officials for games previously worked.

### TOWN OF NEWBURGH EQUIPMENT SPECIFICATIONS CHARTER BUS SERVICE FOR RECREATION DEPARTMENT TRIP PROGAM

- 1. All buses must be model year **2020** or newer and equipped with anti-lock brakes.
- 2. The exterior of the bus must be well painted and clean with no signs of damage.
- 3. The interior of the bus must be clean with upholstery and flooring in good condition.
- 4. All on-board restroom facilities must be completely functioning and clean. Restrooms must be serviced as often as necessary to avoid offensive odors in the rear portion of the bus.
- 5. Air-conditioning and heating must be in excellent working order.
- 6. All buses provided for scheduled trips MUST be in good condition and meet all Department of Transportation, Federal Highway Administration rules, regulations and guidelines. All maintenance records for buses to be provided must be available to the Town of Newburgh for inspection.
- 7. If an inspection of your bus or buses is requested by the Town of Newburgh, the inspection should take place within ten (10) working days of request. The records for the bus or buses MUST BE WITH THE BUS OR BUSES AT THE TIME OF THE INSPECTION. Failure to provide these records will eliminate your bid from consideration.
- 8. Vendor will be responsible for compliance with all DOT/FHWA regulations with regard to their service for The Town of Newburgh bus trip. If more than one (1) driver per bus is needed based on the bid itinerary, it is the vendor's responsibility to determine this need.
- 9. Any backup or replacement buses used must meet the same criteria as originally required in the bid specifications.
- 10. Buses shall have a capacity of at least 49 passengers plus driver, except, if the trip list specifies a larger passenger capacity, the bus provided must have at least that capacity.

Bidders shall specify the equipment proposed to be used in fulfilling the contract. Sufficient information to identify and assess the equipment shall be provided. As a minimum, provide the number of units, make, model, age, mileage, condition, style and capacity of the equipment that is proposed to be provided.

The successful bidder(s) shall supply and maintain insurance which defends, indemnifies and holds harmless the Town of Newburgh, its officers, employees and agents from and against any and all liability, damage claims, demands, costs, judgments, fees, attorney's fees or loss arising directly out of acts or omissions hereunder by the contractor or third party under the direction or control of the contractor.

The successful bidder(s) must furnish the Town with a Certificate of Insurance prior to commencement of work showing coverage in effect. If the certificate will expire before the trip(s) will be taken, a new certificate must be received fifteen (15) days prior to the expiration of your current policy. Insurance certificates, in addition to proof of coverage, shall contain the standard Accord statement pertaining to written notification to the Town of Newburgh in the event of cancellation, with a thirty (30) day notification period.

INSURANCE CERTIFICATES SHALL NAME THE TOWN OF NEWBURGH AS AN ADDITIONAL INSURED PARTY AND SHALL STATE THAT ALL COVERAGE SHALL BE PRIMARY TO ANY OTHER INSURANCE COVERAGE HELD BY THE TOWN WITH RESPECT TO ACTS OR OMISSIONS OF THE NAMED INSURED.

A fax copy of the certificate may be sent to the Town Clerk for purposes of the bid, but the original certificate of insurance must be received by the Town Clerk at least five (5) days prior to the scheduled trip date.

The Town reserves the right to terminate the contract if the vendor fails to keep these policies in force for the above amounts or for the duration of the contract period.

### **Terms and Conditions**

- 1. Bids are required to be submitted and will be awarded on an individual trip basis. If the vendor defaults in the performance of any trip, however, the Town reserves the right to terminate the bid award(s) to that vendor for all remaining awarded trips and to award the trip to the next lowest responsible bidder(s) for those trips.
- 2. The prices quoted herein, if accepted, will be considered guaranteed, unadjustable prices for the terms stated herein, unless otherwise so identified in other sections of this bid request.
- 3. The terms of the agreement awarded from this bid will commence on date of award and expire December 31, 2025, unless otherwise specified in this Request for Proposal/Quotation.
- 4. This bid agreement shall override any previous agreements for this item(s), except as otherwise provided herein.
- 5. The Town of Newburgh reserves the right to reject any and all bids if deemed in the best interest of the Town to do so. The Town shall have the authority to award orders, contracts, or services to the bidder(s) best meeting the specifications and conditions as judged solely by the Town.
- 6. All services shall be performed as described in this bid and shall comply in all respects with applicable Federal, State, County and Town Statues and Codes.
- 7. The Town Board shall determine whether bid exceptions are minor in nature or represent a serious departure from the purpose and intent of the specifications and whether or not the best interests of the Town will be promoted by waiving original requirements and accepting exceptions.
- 8. The Town of Newburgh assumes no responsibility and no liability for costs incurred by bidders prior to the issuance of an agreement, contract or purchase order.
- 9. Vendors who submit a Proposal(s) in response to this bid may be required to give an oral presentation of their Proposal(s). The purpose of such presentation is to provide an opportunity for the vendor to clarify or elaborate on their bid.
- 10. Bids are solicited only from competent, experienced and financially qualified vendors who meet all the qualifications and or specifications of this bid document as determined solely by the Town of Newburgh.
- 11. The Town reserves the right to utilize transportation service from the successful bidder(s) for any and all programs and trips listed herein and to eliminate any program or trip location upon 48 hours notice before coach bus trips and 24 hours notice before school bus trips, at its discretion.
- 12. The Town reserves the right to request transportation service for additional programs and trips that are anticipated but cannot be identified at this time. Additional services needed shall be negotiated on an as needed basis based on trip location, time and service availability. The Town will solicit prices in accordance with its purchase policy guidelines.

### **Payment for Work Performed**

Payment will be made on the completion of each trip for service in accordance with the price schedule submitted by the successful bidder(s). The Town does not guarantee the actual number of each item that will actually be required. The Town shall be held harmless by the successful bidder(s) for lost revenue, profit or any other hardship due to the actual services procured during the award period.

### **Bidder Qualification Requirements**

- Bids will only be accepted from thoroughly competent, experienced and financially qualified transportation service firms as determined solely by the Town of Newburgh. The bidder must demonstrate, upon request, that is had five (5) years immediate acceptable prior experience in providing such services. The Town will be the sole judge as to any bidder's fulfillment of the stated requirements and qualifications.
- 2. All bidders must have a current and valid transportation business registration, licenses and permits as required by law at the time of bid submission and must remain valid for the entirety of the contract period.
- 3. All bidders and their commercial licensed drivers must hold a current and valid New York State Drivers License for providing this service.
- 4. All bidders shall be required to execute and submit a non-collusion statement with their bids in accordance with New York State law.
- 5. All bidders must supply at least three (3) references, including contact persons name, address and phone number for which they have provided similar services.

6. The successful bidder must comply with New York State Labor Laws.

### **Cancellation/Termination**

Cancellation does not release the Vendor from its obligation to provide goods or services per the terms of the contract during the notification period.

The Committee on Open Government is authorized to issue advisory opinions. The ensuing advisory opinion is based solely upon the information presented in your correspondence.

As you know, as of September 4, 2024, article six of the Freedom of Information Law ("FOIL") was amended by <u>Chapter 302 of the Laws of 2024</u> to include a mandate that "[a]ll agencies subject to the requirements of this article shall develop a policy regarding providing a notification to public employees in the event that the agency is responding to a request for such employee's disciplinary records." <u>Public</u> Officers Law ("POL") § 87(6).

We are writing in response to your request for an advisory opinion concerning the implementation of the mandate and the notification it contemplates. In order to provide such advice we must look to the <u>text of the amendment</u> and the legislative intent included with the <u>memorandum accompanying the</u> <u>amendment</u>. In the following advisory, we seek to address your inquiries.

# Does POL § 87(6) require notification to current and former public employees, or just currently employed public employees?

The text of the amendment does not define the term "public employee" for purposes of notification. We suggest that FOIL responsible entities look to holdings of courts finding that the 2020 amendment to FOIL, which required that law enforcement disciplinary records be subject to review and disclosure, applies equally to former law enforcement employees and current law enforcement employees.

# Is there a penalty if an agency does not provide the notification? If there is a penalty, what is the penalty?

The text of the amendment does not include language imposing a penalty for non-compliance with the notification requirement nor does it include a remedy for public employees if notification is not provided to them in accordance with the statute. The memo accompanying the amendment is also silent on this matter.

What must be included in the notification and when must it be sent?

Although the text of the amendment does not make it clear when the required notification must be made – stating only that it is required "in the event that an agency *is responding* to a request" (emphasis added) – the memo accompanying the amendment contains some language which may explain the intention of the legislature on this question. The memo provides: "[t]his legislation simply recognizes that these impacted public employees should have *minimum* notice when their personal information *has been released* to the public" (emphasis added), suggesting that it is the legislature's intention that the required notification be "minimal" and be made to the employee *after* the records have been released. The intention regarding the timing of the minimal notification (*i.e.*, after the release of the requested records) is strengthened by the following language from the memo: "[this amendment] would simply ensure that if a public employee's personal information *has been released to the public*, then such affected employee would have notice of such release" (emphasis added).

Where must the notification to the public employee be sent? E.g., work address? Email address? Home address? If notification must be sent to a home address or email address, what if the agency does not have those addresses? If notification must be sent to a former public employee, what is an agency to do if it does not possess a current address for that former public employee?

The amendment requires that agencies develop a policy regarding the required notification but does not establish specific procedures for issuing the notification. We recommend that agency heads use their best judgement as to the most appropriate form of notification. While the text is silent on this matter, it is our opinion that the notification should be in writing so that the agency has evidence of compliance and that notice by either regular mail or email is sufficient. Agencies should make reasonable efforts to notify former employees and document their efforts to do so.

Does the legislation require that the affected public employee be provided with a copy of the FOIL request that is the subject of the POL § 87(6) notification and/or copies of the records that are provided to the requestor in response to the request?

As noted above, the amendment requires that agencies develop a policy regarding the required notification, but it does not establish specific procedures for issuing the notification. The <u>memo</u> accompanying the bill indicates that it is the intention of the legislature that the required policy and notification requirement "have no effect on the release of information that is now permissible" pursuant to FOIL. We understand this to mean that the legislature intends that whatever policy a FOIL responsible entity adopts to effectuate the new notice requirement, such policy may not serve as an impediment to hinder or delay the required production of affected records in response to a FOIL request.

While the text of the amendment does not reflect a proactive requirement on the part of the agency to provide the public employee a copy of the FOIL request or the responsive records, it is important to note that the request and responsive records are, themselves, "records" subject to rights of access under FOIL. *See* previously prepared advisory opinions on this topic linked below.

Although not specifically raised as one of your questions, we have also been asked what constitutes a "disciplinary record" and, specifically, whether "counseling memos" are considered disciplinary records. We suggest that in the absence of a statutory definition of the term "disciplinary record" as it applies to non-law enforcement employees, FOIL-responsible agencies look to <u>POL § 86(6)</u>, which defines "law enforcement disciplinary records," for guidance.

Simon Enclosed are copies of a letter from Cathy Drobny, Esq. of Hacker Murphy LLP regarding the above referenced proposed settlement, a proposed Stipulation of Settlement and Order and charts showing the claimed refund liability and the approximate refunds that will be due from the taxing jurisdictions under the proposed settlement of the above referenced real property tax assessment appeal. Also enclosed is a map showing the location of the tax parcel which is the subject of the proceedings which contains an approximately 3,665 square foot bank building and related improvements.

The settlement provides for reductions for 2021, 2022, 2023 and 2024 in Assessed Value of \$14,400 from \$364,000 to \$350,000. The 2023 Assessed Value will hold for the 2025, 2026 and 2027 assessment rolls pursuant to the provisions of RPTL Section 727, subject to the statutory exceptions.

The charts indicates that the refund liability for the Town (including Highway but not including special districts and the Fire District) will be approximately \$832.12 versus claimed refund liability of approximately \$14,388.72. The Goodwill Fire District's refund liability under the settlement will be approximately \$350.56. The Newburgh School District's refund liability will be approximately \$4,057.32, with an additional Library refund of approximately 205.95. The School District's attorneys will also be signing the Stipulation of Settlement.

Also attached is a proposed resolution which would authorize the Settlement.

Attached please find the proposed Stipulation of Settlement relative to the above-referenced matter.

December 23, 2024

There are currently four (4) years pending. The subject parcel is a Chase Bank, approximately 3,665 sq. ft., located at 201 Auto Park Place (Tax Map #97-2-48.297-1-28.1). The FMV as assessed ranges from \$1,289,911 in 2021 to \$1,768932 in 2024 (assessed value is \$364,400 for all years). After reviewing the lease, income and expense statement and sales of properties similar to the subject, this settlement was negotiated.

The proposed settlement reduces the assessed value to \$350,000 for all years resulting in equalized FMVs of \$1,238,938 for 2021, \$1,417004 for 2022, \$1,621,121 for 2023 and \$1,699,029 for 2024. The 2024 assessed value as reduced will be held for 2025, 2026 and 2027 pursuant to RPTL §727, subject to the statutory exceptions. After considering the costs of trial-ready appraisals and future litigation expenses, we feel that this is a good settlement. Attached for your review are copies of the refund liability charts, which show the potential liability versus the proposed settlement refund liability.

We recommend that the Town Board authorize us to enter into this settlement as proposed. Please place this matter on the agenda for the next Newburgh Town Board meeting for approval. Once the Resolution passes, please let me know and I will sign the Order. Please do not hesitate to contact me if you have any questions.
