## INTRODUCTORY LOCAL LAW #\_\_ OF 2012 A LOCAL LAW AMENDING CHAPTER 185 ENTITLED "ZONING" OF THE CODE OF THE TOWN OF NEWBURGH AND THE ZONING MAP OF THE TOWN OF NEWBURGH TO REZONE A PORTION OF TAX PARCEL SECTION 34 BLOCK 2 LOT 16.3 OFF OF NEW ROAD

## SECTION 1 - TITLE

This Local Law shall be referred to as "A Local Law Amending Chapter 185 Entitled 'Zoning' of the Code of the Town of Newburgh and the Zoning Map of the Town of Newburgh to Rezone A Portion of Tax Parcel Section 34 Block 2 Lot 16.3 off of New Road."

#### SECTION 2 - PURPOSE

The purpose of this local law is to rezone a certain section of a parcel of land located off of New Road from the B (Business) Zoning District to the adjoining R-2 (Residence) Zoning District.

"(b) Commercial site: \$1,500, plus \$250 per 1,000 square feet of floor area for the first 200,000 square feet and \$100 per 1,000 square feet of the floor area greater than 200,000 square feet."

2. Subsection 104-2(C)(3)(d) of Section 104-2 entitled "Planning, zoning and building fees" of Chapter 104 entitled "Schedule of Fees" of the Town of Newburgh Municipal Code be and hereby is amended to read as follows:

"(d) For structures 100,000 square feet and greater: \$5,000, plus \$0.70 per square foot of floor area for the first 100,000 square feet and \$0.35 per square foot for the floor area

Subsection 104-2(C)(6) of Subsection 104-2(C) entitled "Building permit applications" of 3. Section 104-2 entitled "Planning, zoning and building fees" of Chapter 104 entitled "Schedule of Fees" of the Town of Newburgh Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

- Upon filing of an application for a building permit for demolition, the following fee "(6) shall be charged:
  - (a) Residential structure: \$100 per story. \$300 per story for structure up to 15' in height (b) Commercial structure: \$700 for structure 15' to 25' in height \$1,300 for structure 25' to 35' in height \$2,200 for structure 35' to 45' in height \$3.550 for structure 45' to 55' in height \$5,575 for structure 55' to 65' in height \$5,575 plus \$1,500 for each additional 10 feet in height for structures over 65' in height

(c) Residential accessory structure: \$50 per story."

A new Subsection 104-2(C)(7) is hereby added to Subsection 104-2(C) entitled 4. "Building permit applications" of Section 104-2 entitled "Planning, zoning and building fees" of Chapter 104 entitled "Schedule of Fees" of the Town of Newburgh Municipal Code to read as follows:

Upon an applicant filing for the reissuance of a building permit that previously "(7) was issued and has expired, absent other circumstances, the permit will be reissued upon payment of the following fee based upon the time of expiration of the permit:

(a)	0 to 12 months	10% of the original permit fee
(b)	12 to 24 months	20% of the original permit fee
(c)	24 to 36 months	30% of the original permit fee
(d)	36 to 48 months	40% of the original permit fee

- The title of Subsection 104-2(E) be and hereby is amended to read as follows: 5.

"E. Subdivision, site plan, architectural review, site preparation, use variance, and area variance, special permit and interpretation application professional service fees.

6. Subsection 104-2(E)(4) of Section 104-2 entitled "Planning, zoning and building fees" of Chapter 104 entitled "Schedule of Fees" of the Town of Newburgh Municipal Code be and hereby is amended to read as follows:

"(4) Fees for certain actions before the Zoning Board of Appeals.

(a) Upon application to the Town of Newburgh Zoning Board of Appeals for certain complex use or area variances, <u>special permits</u>, <u>interpretations and other applications</u> which the Zoning Board of Appeals is authorized to hear, or later determination by the Zoning Board of Appeals that consultant services are required, the applicant shall deposit with the Secretary to the Zoning Board of Appeals an escrow to cover the costs being incurred by the Town for consultant services, including but not limited to engineering, planning and legal as well as clerical costs, incurred in the processing and reviewing of such application.

(b) The Town of Newburgh Zoning Board of Appeals shall compute the initial escrow charge in accordance with the following schedule:

[1] Use or area variance for commercial lot or use (except signs):	\$1,000.
[2] Use or area variance for multiple dwelling residential site:	\$1,000.
[3] Special permit:	\$1,000.
[4] Interpretation for commercial lot or use or multiple dwelling residential site or use:	<u>\$1,000.</u>
[5] All other applications for commercial or multiple dwelling residential lot, site or use which the Zoning Board of Appeals is authorized to hear:	<u>\$1,000.</u>

(c) Review <u>escrow</u> fee deposits shall be made to the Secretary to the Zoning Board of Appeals and shall be placed in a separate non-interest-bearing account by the Town of Newburgh.

(d) If the escrow account falls below 40% of the initial deposit, the Zoning Board of Appeals may require that the applicant pay additional funds into the escrow account up to 100% of the initial deposit

(d) (c) In the event that an applicant shall withdraw his application at any stage of the proceedings or when the application review and approval process has been

completed, the balance of funds after payment of all outstanding charges in the applicant's account shall be remitted to the applicant within 60 days of the decision by the Zoning Board of Appeals."

 Subsection 104-3(B)(2) of Section 104-3 entitled "Sanitation and water fees" of Chapter 104 entitled "Schedule of Fees" of the Town of Newburgh Municipal Code be and hereby is amended to read as follows:

"(2) Meter rates. Meter rates for the sale of water to all consumers within the Consolidated Water District and Colden Park Water District of the Town of Newburgh and the duly constituted extensions thereto, excluding water sold to the Town of New Windsor, the New York State Thruway Authority or outside-thedistrict users, shall be as follows:

First 7,500 gallons	\$11.00 (minimum charge per
	quarter)
Next 10,000 gallons	\$2.48 per 1,000 gallons
Next 82,500 gallons	\$4.20 per 1,000 gallons

- (a) A penalty equal to 5% of the original bill shall be added to the metered water charges if not paid in full within 30 days from the due and payable date.
- (b) The Town of New Windsor, the New York State Thruway Authority and the outside-the-district users will pay rates and charges as per agreements entered into with the town. In the event that water assessments under the benefit formula cannot be made applicable for any reason to any consumer and any agreement between the town and such users does not reflect payment of the same in one form or another, the town reserves the right to surcharge such users as to meter rates so as to provide for equitable payment of all charges between all users, said surcharge to be applicable in the last calendar quarter charge.
- (c) The water rates for the Stewart ANG Base Water District consumer(s) will be established by the Town Board from time to time in accordance with New York State Town Law Section 198. Unpaid water charges in arrears for 30

days or longer shall be subject to such penalty as the Town Board may provide for by resolution subject to the limit established by Town Law Section 198."
