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RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF A GRANT AGREEMENT WITH THE NYS ENVIRONMENTAL FACILITIES CORPORATION (EFC) AND CLASSIFYING THE WEST SIDE ORANGE LAKE FAILING SEPTIC REPLACEMENT STUDY PROJECT AWARDED ENGINEERING PLANNING GRANT (EPG) FUNDING FROM THE EFC TO CONSTITUTE A TYPE III ACTION UNDER THE STATE ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY REVIEW ACT (SEQRA) ID# 110685

Councilman/woman _____ presented the following resolution which was seconded by

WHEREAS, State of New York grant funding is available through the NYS Environmental Facilities Corporation (EFC) Engineering Planning Grant Program (EPG) to support feasibility and engineering studies for the effective collection, conveyance, and treatment of municipal wastewater and other potential public sewer system projects which are undertaken by eligible municipalities; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Newburgh (Town) has been awarded \$20,000 in EPG funding from the EFC with an ID# 110685; and

WHEREAS, the Town will use the EPG funding to evaluate feasible solutions and alternatives to replace on-site septic systems on the West Side of Orange Lake that are believed to be contaminating drinking water wells and the larger Orange Lake watershied; and

WHEREAS, Title 6 of the New York Code of Rules and Regulations (6 NYCRR) Section 617.5 under the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) provides that certain actions identified in subdivision (c) of that section are not subject to environmental review under the Environmental Conservation Law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Deputy Town Supervisor, Scott Manley, is authorized to execute a Grant Agreement with the NYS Environmental Facilities Corporation and any and all other contracts, documents, and instruments necessary to bring about the project and to fulfill the Town of Newburgh's obligations under the Grant Agreement, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Town of Newburgh authorizes and will appropriate a minimum 20% local match as required by the Engineering Planning Grant Program (EPG) for the West Side Orange Lake Failing Septic Replacement Study Project. Under the EPG Program, the local match must be at least 20% of the EPG grant award of \$20,000. The source of the local match, and any amount in excess of the required match, shall be provided jointly by the Town of Newburgh and the Orange Lake Homeowners Association, divided 50% for each entity. The maximum local match shall not exceed a total of \$4,000 based upon a total estimated project cost of \$24,000. The Deputy Town Supervisor may increase the local match without further approval from the Town Board only through the use of in-kind services, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, the Town Board of the Town of Newburgh hereby determines that the proposed West Side Orange Lake Failing Septic Replacement Study Project as described in its grant application to the EFC under the EPG is a Type II Action in accordance with 6 NYCRR Section 617.5(c)(24), such action constituting the "information collection, including basic data collection and research; water quality and pollution studies, engineering studies; surveys;

subsurface investigations; and/or soils studies that do not commit the agency, to wit: the Town of Newburgh, to undertake, fund, or approve any Type I or Unlisted action" and such action is therefore not subject to further review under 6 NYCRR Part 617.
