Comments:

The Planning Department has reviewed the submitted materials regarding the appeal for an area variance. While the Zoning Board of Appeals must weigh the local issues in balancing the needs of the appellant with the potential impacts on the surrounding area, it does not appear that intermunicipal or countywide impacts would result if the board finds that granting relief is warranted in this matter.

We note that the proposed project is substantially larger than the existing development onsite. While the proposed lot consolidation and development configuration will assist with the current development crowding conditions at this intersection, crowding will still occur. We advise the ZBA to review the application to determine whether the variances can be decreased in magnitude—if, for instance, the canopy can be lowered or moved further back from the intersection, or if the onsite signage can be decreased in size. Given all the area variances needed, perhaps the scale of the project is too large for the intended site. We look forward to reviewing this project upon its referral from the Planning Board.
