## **Comments:**

County Planning is in receipt of the GML §239 referral for the above referenced Project. Based upon our review of the submitted materials, our office has found no evidence that significant inter-municipal or county-wide impacts would result from its approval. County Planning recommends that the Board make a decision only after weighing the benefit to be realized by the applicant against the potential detriment to the health safety and general welfare of the neighborhood and/or community. Our office offers the following advisory comments.

1. County Planning recommends that the Applicant pursue an appropriate cross easement with the adjoining parcel to the north in order to allow continued use of the driveway and apartment access. In the event the adjoining land owner is unwilling to provide the easement, our office recommends that the Applicant alter the steps to the south side of the deck and discontinue use of the driveway, re-establishing a vegetative cover. In addition a fence or guiderail may be necessary to prevent continued use of the adjoining parcel.
