#### INTRODUCTORY LOCAL LAW NO. 7 OF THE YEAR 2018 AMENDING SECTION 56-10 ENTITLED "FILING OF COMPLAINTS" OF CHAPTER 56 ENTITLED "ANIMALS" OF THE CODE OF THE TOWN OF NEWBURGH

BE IT ENACTED by the Town Board of the Town of Newburgh as follows:

#### SECTION 1 - TITLE

This Local Law shall be referred to as "A Local Law Amending Section 56-10 entitled 'Filing of Complaints' of Chapter 56 entitled 'Animals' of the Code of the Town of Newburgh".

#### SECTION 2 - AMENDMENT

Section 56-10 entitled "Filing of complaints" of Chapter 56 entitled "Animals" of the Code of the Town of Newburgh to read as follows:

#### "§ 56-10 Filing of complaints.

Any person who observes a dog in violation of this article may file a complaint under oath as defined by Section 210.00 of the Penal Law of the State of New York or by written instrument bearing a notice that false statements therein are punishable under Section 210.45 of the Penal Law with the Animal Control Department of the Town of Newburgh specifying the nature of the violation, the date thereof, a description of the dog and the name and residence, if known, of the owner of such dog. Such complaint may serve as the basis for enforcing the provisions of this article."

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#### SECTION 3 - VALIDITY

The invalidity of any provision of this Local Law shall not affect the validity of any other provision of this Local Law that can be given effect without such invalid provision.

#### SECTION 4 - EFFECTIVE DATE

This Local Law shall take effect immediately when it is filed in the Office of the New York State Secretary of State in accordance with Section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.

#### TOWN OF NEWBURGH

#### A LOCAL LAW AMENDING CHAPTER 104 ENTITLED "SCHEDULE OF FEES" OF THE TOWN OF NEWBURGH MUNICIPAL CODE: ELECTRONIC MESSAGE DISPLAY SIGNS SPECIAL USE PERMIT FEES

BE IT ENACTED by the Town Board of the Town of Newburgh, County of Orange as follows:

<u>SECTION 1</u> - <u>TITLE</u> This Local Law shall be referred to as "A Local Law Amending Chapter 104 entitled 'Schedule of Fees' of the Code of the Town of Newburgh: Electronic Message Display Signs Special Use Permit Fees".

#### SECTION 2 - AMENDMENTS TO CHAPTER 104

- A. Subsection B of Section 104-2 entitled "Planning, zoning and building fees" of Chapter 104 entitled "Schedule of Fees" of the Town of Newburgh Municipal Code be and hereby is amended as follows:
  - 1. The tile of Subsection B of Section 104-2 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Site plan and special use permit review. (See Chapter 185, Zoning.)"

2. A new sub-subsection 104-2B(1)(c) is hereby added to read as follows:

(1) Application fee.

"(c) Electronic message display sign special use permit: \$150 per sign."

- B. Subsection E of Section 104-2 entitled "Planning, zoning and building fees" of Chapter 104 entitled "Schedule of Fees" of the Town of Newburgh Municipal Code be and hereby is amended as follows:
  - 1. A new sub-subsection 104-2E(2)(b)[6] is hereby added to read as follows:

(b) The Town of Newburgh Planning Board shall compute the initial escrow charge in accordance with the following schedule:

"[6] Electronic message display sign special use permit: \$500 per sign, except if designated as a

Type II SEQRA action, \$1,000 plus \$500 per sign."

#### SECTION 3 - PENDING APPLICATIONS

Applications which are pending before the appropriate Board or department of the Town of Newburgh as of the effective date of this Local Law and for which fees or partial fees have already been paid shall be subject to the fees set forth in Chapter 104 prior to this amendment with respect to those fees already paid and the fees established herein shall apply only to fees which were unpaid or applications submitted after the effective date of this Local Law.

#### SECTION 4 - VALIDITY

The invalidity of any provision of this Local Law shall not affect the validity of any other provision of this Local Law that can be given effect without such invalid provision.

#### SECTION 5 - EFFECTIVE DATE

This Local Law shall take effect on the later of the date it is filed in the Office of the New York State Secretary of State in accordance with Section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.

B. Site plan and special use permit review. (See Chapter 185, Zoning.)

(1) Application fee.

(a) Residential site:

[1] Site plan containing four dwelling units or less (payable at application): \$500, plus \$200 per dwelling unit.

[2] Site plan containing 10 dwelling units or less (payable at application): \$1,000, plus \$225 per dwelling unit.

[3] Site plan containing 25 dwelling units or less (payable at application): \$2,000, plus \$250 per dwelling unit.

[4] Site plan containing more than 25 dwelling units (payable at application): \$4,000, plus \$250 per dwelling unit

(b) Commercial site: \$1,500, plus \$250 per 1,000 square feet of floor area for the first 200,000 square feet and \$100 per 1,000 square feet of the floor area greater than 200,000 square feet. [Amended 12-17-2012 by L.L. No. 9-2012]

(c) Electronic message display sign special use permit: \$150 per sign

(2) Inspection of public improvements: 4% of value of bonded improvements.

(3) Cost of professional services required in site plan review process: see § 104-2D(3).

(4) Recreation fee in lieu of land for multifamily dwellings: \$2,000 per unit.

(5) Public hearings: \$150, plus publication and transcription costs.

(6) Cost of professional services required for architectural review performed in connection with site plan review process: see § 104-2D(3).

(7) Costs of professional services in connection with site plans with respect to inspections of landscaping installations and soil and erosion settlement control measures, establishment or extension of special improvement districts, outside user agreements, developer agreements, road abandonments, easements over Town property and review of proposed dedication instruments, including deeds, easements, securities and insurance: See § 104-2G.

(b)The Town of Newburgh Planning Board shall compute the initial escrow charge in accordance with the following schedule:

[1] Residential subdivision: \$500 per lot for each lot up to five lots and \$300 per lot for each lot over five lots.

[2] Commercial subdivision: \$1,000 per lot for each lot up to five lots, and \$500 per lot for each lot over five lots.

[3] Multifamily residential site plans and special permits: \$250 per unit for each unit up to 50 units, and \$100 per unit for each unit over 50 units.

[4] Commercial or other nonresidential site plans and special permits: \$1,000, plus \$200 per

1,000 square feet of building floor area or part thereof.

[5] State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA):

[Amended 12-16-2013 by L.L. No. 9-2013]

[a] Short environmental assessment form: \$1,000.

[b] Long environmental assessment form: \$2,000.

[c] Environmental impact statement: \$7,500.

[d] Inspection fee for subdivisions: 5% of amount of performance bond.

[6] Electronic message display sign special use permit: \$500 per sign, except if designated as a Type II SEORA Action, \$1,000 plus \$500 per sign.

### Memorandum of Understanding

Between Kiewit Shea Constructors, AJV and Town of Newburgh

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) sets forth the terms and understandings between Kiewit Shea Constructors, AJV (KSC) and the Town of Newburgh (TON) regarding the transportation of the steel pipe sections from Steelways, Inc. property located at 401 South Water Street, Newburgh, New York to the KSC jobsite located at 5503 NYS Route 9W, Marlboro (Town of Newburgh), New York. This transportation of these materials is necessary to the successful completion of the project known as BT-2 Rondout West Bypass Tunnel of the City of New York.

#### Background

Representatives of KSC and TON met on May 26, 2016 and August 3, 2016 to apprise the TON as to the proposed storage location and proposed transportation route through the TON for the steel pipe sections. As for the transportation route of the steel pipe sections it was important to receive approval from the TON before plans could be finalized and contracts could be executed between KSC and their subcontractors and suppliers.

#### Purpose

This MOU memorializes the mutual understanding and agreement between KSC and TON regarding the transportation of the steel pipe sections.

#### Route

The agreed upon route is to head north on New York State Reference Route 980T from 401 South Water Street, Newburgh, New York for 2.0 miles. Turn right onto Old Balmville Road for 1.5 miles. Turn right onto US 9W North for 3.1 miles arriving at 5503 NYS Route 9W Marlboro (Town of Newburgh), New York (see attached map).

#### **Commitments**

KSC agrees to undertake the following:

1) Based on records of Old Balmville Road supplied by TON, where available, responses by utility companies and appropriate field investigations, KSC or its subcontractor will verify the utilities and drainage pipes below the road are able to handle the transport of the steel pipe sections without sustaining damage. If temporary support is necessary, KSC will submit the design plans for the support to the TON for its approval, not to be

unreasonably delayed or withheld, before installing. A summary report of the data and conclusions in conformance with the requirements outlined in Schedule A (attached) shall be submitted to the TON for its review and approval prior to any use of town roads by KSC for shipments. KSC shall allow four (4) weeks for the report to be reviewed and approved prior to commencement of Heavy Deliveries. KSC shall address any questions or comments made by the Town, if necessary. For all other quarterly inspections, KSC shall provide at least one (1) week notice to the TON.

- 2) KSC or its subcontractor will engage an independent consultant to perform borings along Old Balmville Road to determine bearing capacity and to establish improvement plans acceptable to the TON, which KSC will implement should it become necessary. KSC will submit the improvement plans to the TON for its written approval, to be reviewed within 30 days not to be unreasonably withheld or delayed, which approval must be received by KSC prior to the first shipment being made. Should improvements be needed upon pavement inspection, KSC shall develop separate plans to be submitted for approval by the TON prior to implementation. During construction, KSC shall perform temporary repairs to Roadways (e.g. fill potholes) to address damage to Roadways caused by Project construction activities, provided such damage impairs the safety of the involved Roadway and the Town provides a written notice (by email or other written method) to KSC of such damage. The Town hereby agrees that an acceptable method to repair holes in Old Balmville Road is to fill potholes with a cold patch.
- 3) KSC or its subcontractor will photographically document the existing condition of the road in conformance with the requirements outlined in Schedule A (attached) and submit such photographic documentation to the Town.
- 4) KSC or its subcontractor will obtain such permits or approvals as may be required by the New York State Department of Transportation ("NYSDOT") for the transport of pipe sections over the NYSDOT's bridge on Old Balmville Road across Interstate 84 and present satisfactory written documentation to the TON that it has either obtained such permit or approval or that the NYSDOT does not require a permit or approval prior to commencing the transport of the pipe sections.
- 5) KSC or its subcontractor will transport pipe sections at night to have trucks off the road prior to 7:00 AM with an anticipated start in October 2018 for purposes of proving clearances to utilities along the alignment and then in July-August 2019 to transport the remaining pipe. Shipments will be made Sunday to Thursday and will not begin until 11:00 PM and be off of the road by 6:00 a.m. Shipments will be permitted Saturday but will not begin until 1:00 a.m. and be off of the road by 7:00 a.m. KSC or its subcontractor will endeavor to minimize light and sound impacts to the surrounding neighborhoods. In the event that Town of Newburgh police are needed in support of shipments, KSC will reimburse the TON for those costs.
- 6) KSC or its subcontractor will transport two (2) to four (4) pipe sections per day. Return trips from the jobsite to 401 Water Street, Newburgh, NY will use Route 9W South to reduce the disturbance to the Balmville community as well as wear and tear on Old Balmville Road. Upon commencement of the pipe transport trips, KSC or its subcontractor will submit quarterly pavement assessment reports on the effect the vehicular loads are having on the roadway. Such reports shall be prepared in accordance with the methods and means of evaluation, contain the detail and be in the format specified in the Scope annexed hereto and made a part hereof as Schedule "A." TON's

consultant will review each submitted pavement assessment report and perform spot checks. In the event the pavement assessment report or check indicates damage to the roadway caused by KSC, KSC or its subcontractor will promptly perform the remediation or repairs recommended by TON's consultant or reasonably requested by TON as soon as practicable following receipt of notice from TON. Such repairs will be consistent with industry standards for repairs to similar type needs.

- 7) KSC or its subcontractor will provide a Supply Bond, at least one month prior to the first shipment, to repair Old Balmville Road and any damaged utilities, pipes or culverts below the road in a manner reasonably satisfactory to the TON, issued by a surety authorized to issue surety bonds in New York State reasonably acceptable to the TON and in a form and amount to be determined and agreed between TON and KSC. The amount of the bond shall be \$350,000. Upon KSC's or subcontractors final cessation of use of Old Balmville Road and prior to release of the Supply Bond, a final assessment shall be performed of the pavement, utilities, drainage pipes and culverts.
- 8) KSC or its subcontractor will coordinate with Central Hudson, Verizon and Spectrum to provide the necessary clearances for the transportation of the pipe sections.
- 9) Notwithstanding anything to the contrary, KSC's obligations under this Agreement are only to repair in accordance with industry standards its proportional share of any damage it causes to the roadway or utilities. Normal wear and tear and damage done by others is excluded.

Normal wear and tear includes use of the road by the public including KSC within the design load bearing capacity of the road. TON's right to approve shall in all cases be consistent with industry standards and this Agreement.

#### **TON's Remedies for Default on Commitments**

If KSC or its subcontractor shall fail to timely perform or honor any of its above commitments except those secured by a duly delivered Supply Bond, acceptable to the TON, other than for reasons of *force majeure*, including acts of God (such as, but not limited to, fires, explosions, earthquakes, drought, tidal waves and floods); war, hostilities (whether war be declared or not), invasion, act of foreign enemies, governmental mobilization, requisition, or embargo; rebellion, revolution, insurrection, or military or usurped power, or civil war; contamination by radio-activity; riot, strikes, lock outs or similar disorder, unless solely restricted to employees of KSC or its subcontractors; or acts or threats of terrorism, then KSC shall pay to the TON a penalty in the sum of \$10,000.00 for each such default or failure, which sum shall be due and payable to the TON by check within 15 days of the date that a written notice of such default or dishonor is mailed to KSC at its below address and after KSC is given a reasonable time to cure such default after the notice. Each such event shall be subject to a separate penalty. If KSC shall fail to timely delivery payment of such penalty (ies) to the TON then KSC shall additionally be responsible for the reimbursement of the TON's reasonable attorney's fees and costs in enforcing this provision.

#### Funding

KSC shall submit a check payable to the TON for the sum of  $_16,700$  which the TON shall deposit into a trust account and make withdrawals upon solely to pay the costs of an expert the

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TON retains at its sole discretion to review of the bearing capacity conclusions of the independent consultant's report and the submitted repair plans. Any unused balance shall be refunded to KSC upon payment of the last invoice for the Town's expert's work. All withdrawals will be consistent with the attached proposal from CM and TON will notify KSC of all such withdrawals prior to release. If the amount held in the trust account is depleted, an amount agreed to by KSC and the TON shall be replenished by KSC.

#### Duration

This MOU may be modified by mutual written agreement executed by authorized officials from the Town of Newburgh and Kiewit Shea Constructors, AJV. This MOU shall become effective upon signature by the authorized officials from the TON and KSC and will remain in effect until modified or terminated by mutual consent. In the absence of mutual agreement by the authorized officials from the TON and KSC, this MOU shall end on December 31, 2025, provided that in the event KSC has not repaired damages to Old Balmville Road and/or utilities, pipes or culverts beneath Old Balmville Road which occur during the term of this MOU by December 31, 2025, the obligation to make such repairs shall continue until repairs satisfactory to the TON are completed.

#### SCHEDULE "A"

#### PAVEMENT ASSESSMENT SCOPE

THIS PAVEMENT ASSESSMENT SCOPE, supplements the Memorandum of Understanding between the Town of Newburgh ("Town") and Kiewet Shea Constructors ("KSC").

The Town will allow KSC to use Old Balmville Road and Public Right of Way, subject to the terms and conditions set forth here.

In consideration of the mutual promises and covenants contained herein, the parties do mutually agree as follows:

#### 1. **DEFINITIONS**

As used herein, the following terms shall have the following meanings:

- a. "Scope" means this Pavement Assessment Scope and any and all amendments, exhibits, or schedules attached hereto.
- b. **"Appurtenant Structures"** means additional structures maintained or owned by the Town that are related to Old Balmville Road, such as bridges, culverts, drainage features, guardrails, utilities, and signs.
- c. "Heavy Deliveries" shall mean a trip to transport steel pipe section(s) from Steelways, Inc. property located at 401 South Water Street, Newburgh, New York to the KSC jobsite located at 5503 NYS Route 9W, Marlboro (Town of Newburgh), New York.
- d. "Commencement of Heavy Deliveries" shall mean the earliest date on which Heavy Deliveries occur.
- e. "Public Right-of-Way" or "Town Right-of-Way" or "Right-of-Way" means the surface, the air space in, on, under, through or above the surface and the area in, on, under, through, below or next to the surface of Old Balmville Road.
- f. "Roadway(s)" shall mean Old Balmville Road.

g. "**Town Engineer**" shall mean the Town Engineer and/or a Town-designated consultant with sufficient training and experience to conduct the tasks set forth in this Scope.

#### 2. <u>PAVEMENT ASSESSMENT SCOPE OF WORK</u>

Prior to commencement of Heavy Deliveries, and continuing at no more than quarterly intervals throughout the project duration, the following shall occur:

#### 2.1. Video and Photo Log.

KSC or its subcontractor will drive and video-tape the 1.5 mile segment of Old Balmville Road to be used for deliveries. The video(s) will be completed at low speed (10 to 15 miles per hour). Photos will be taken at intervals of 100 feet or less, plus site specific photos of irregular or damaged pavement for documentation. The video and photos will be taken in both travel directions and will be saved in digital format. Copies of which will be provided to the Town.

#### 2.2. Rutting and Cross-Slope Assessment.

KSC or its subcontractor will record the wheel rut depth and pavement cross-slope in both outer and inner wheel paths. The rutting shall be recorded to the nearest quarter inch using a straight edge (minimum 6'-0" length) across each wheelpath and measuring perpendicular to the deepest point using a measuring stick. The cross-slope shall be recorded to the nearest tenth of a percent by placing a smart level on top of a straight edge (minimum 6'-0" length). A negative percentage shall be recorded to denote a slope in the opposite direction of normal crown. Measurements will be taken at 15 locations (every tenth of a mile). The locations shall be documented by PK nail (to be driven into the shoulder), marked with spraypaint (reapply as needed on each inspection), and a measured offset to the nearest utility pole. The first PK nail shall be located one tenth of a mile north of the intersection of Old Balmville Road and Leroy Place. Appropriate data log sheets are attached to this scope for KSC use.

#### 2.3. Distress Survey

KSC or its subcontractor will record the extent and severity of roadway surface cracking for the first 100 feet of each tenth of a mile segment (as delineated in Task 3- Rutting Assessment) within both lanes of Old Balmville Road. The inventory will include location, type, and magnitude of cracking at a sufficient level of detail to document changes in conditions. For example, alligator cracking will be quantified by square feet,

where as longitudinal and transverse cracking will be quantified by linear foot. The survey will be done with a tape measure or wheel, with locations referenced to stations, or utility pole numbers. Appropriate data log sheets are attached to this scope for KSC use.

#### 2.4. Cross-Culverts

KSC or its subcontractor will identify and document all existing culverts within the 1.5 mile segment of Old Balmville Road (excluding the large culvert 150' north of Lester Road, which will be inspected by the Town's consultant engineer). Photos shall be taken from each end of the culvert which show the end condition as well as the interior condition to the greatest extent possible. The size, material type, and approximate cover depth shall also be recorded. Appropriate data log sheets are attached to this scope for KSC use.

#### 2.5. Control Segment

The videos, photos, rutting, and distress surveys outlined in tasks 2.1, 2.2, and 2.3 above, will also be completed for a control segment on Fostertown Road, located between Old Balmville Road and US Route 9W. The survey shall be conducted on the first 100 feet of roadway west of the Fostertown Road and Old Balmville Road intersection stop sign.

Dear Mr. Piaquadio:

In anticipation of Kiewit Shea Contractors using Old Balmville Road as an oversized-load shipping route, Creighton Manning Engineering, LLP (CM) performed a site inspection of the culvert carrying Old Balmville Road over an unnamed stream approximately 150ft north of the intersection with Lester Road. The scope of this task included completing a field inspection to assess the current condition of the culvert and, if possible, perform calculations to determine the load carrying capacity of the culvert.

For reasons discussed below, this type of culvert is not ratable; however, CM has performed an evaluation to determine the load applied to the culvert resulting from the proposed oversize vehicle. The applied load is significantly less than the deadload of the fill above the culvert, and it is not likely to negatively affect the structure.

### **Inspection Details**

The existing culvert is approximately 72ft long and consists of four distinct sections. Beginning at the upstream (west) fascia, the culvert consists of:

- Section 1 10ft long by 10ft± span cast-in-place concrete arch. This section is located beneath the southbound shoulder of Old Balmville Road
- Section 2 22ft long by 10ft± span mortared stone arch. This section is located directly beneath the north and southbound travel lanes of Old Balmville Road.
- Section 3 21ft long by 8.5ft± span cast-in-place concrete arch presumably placed inside of the original mortared stone arch. This section is located beneath the northbound shoulder and the roadway embankment slope of Old Balmville Road.
- Section 4 19ft long by 8ft± span cast-in-place box culvert. This section appears to be an
  extension of the original culvert and is located under the roadway embankment slope of
  Old Balmville Road.

Based on the height of the upstream headwall, the fill material (including roadway) is a maximum of approximately 10.75ft above the crown of the culvert arch, which reduces to almost no height at the downstream headwall.

Section 1 is in poor to fair condition with pitted concrete below the ordinary high water elevation and localized areas of spalling. There is a  $\frac{1}{2}$  max width horizontal crack emanating from a >6" deep spall in the upstream fascia. There is also a >6" spall at the base of the arch at the interface with the south footing that has revealed two steel members.

Section 2 is in fair condition with no noted gaps or loose stones in the haunches and crown. There is widespread loss of mortar below the ordinary high water elevation along the south end of the arch. Despite the loss of mortar, there were no visible signs of distress or movement of the stones.

G. Plaquadio Old Balmville Rd Culvert Evaluation April 10, 2018

Section 3 is in good condition with three tight vertical cracks along the north abutment wall. One was notably wet during the culvert inspection and the other two were dry with 6"± wide patches of efflorescence, indicating they are routinely wet or were routinely wet in the past. The horizontal joint at the top of the wall at the south abutment was wet along a 5ft± segment near the middle of this section.

Section 4 was in good condition and appeared to have been constructed much more recently than the rest of the structure.

#### **Structure Evaluation**

With no record plans available, this type of structure is not ratable, as the thickness of the concrete and/or stone arch is unknown, and the presence of steel reinforcement within the concrete is unknown.

In order to develop a recommendation for the Town, we consulted the AASHTO LRFD Bridge Design Specifications to estimate the live load that the proposed oversize loads would apply to the culvert. AASHTO 3.6.1.2.6a states:

For single-span culverts, the effects of live load may be neglected where the depth of fill is more than 8.0ft and exceeds the span length

In the case of this culvert, the fill height is approximately 10.75ft and the span is approximately 10ft. Per AASHTO, live load may be neglected for a culvert in this scenario. As an added check, we assumed the structure did not meet the criteria to neglect live load and calculated the theoretical applied load. In this scenario, the proposed load will apply approximately 150 pounds per square foot (PSF) onto the crown of the arch. This is approximately 10 to 15 percent of the soil deadload above the culvert, which is an insignificant increase that is unlikely to have a negative impact on the culvert.
