RESOLUTION OF ADOPTION OF LOCAL LAW NO. OF 2020 AMENDING ARTICLE ii ENTITLED RECORDS RETENTION' OF CHAPTER 144 ENTITLED "RECORDS" OF THE CODE OF THE TOWN OF NEWBURGH

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Newburgh adopted a resolution on the 13th day of October, 2020 ordering a public hearing to beheld on the 26th day of October, 2020 at 7:35 o'clock p.m., prevailing time, to hear all interested parties on Introductory Local Law No. _____ of the Year 2020 entitled "A Local Law Amending Article II Entitled "Records Retention" of Chapter 144 entitled "Records" of the Code of the Town of Newburgh "; and

WHEREAS, a notice of Public Hearing was duly advertised on the __th day of October, 2020 in The Mid-Hudson Times and on the __th day of October, 2020 in The Orange County Post and posted on the Town Clerk's sign board together with a copy of the Local Law on the __th day of October, 2020; and

INTRODUCTORY LOCAL LAW NO. __ OF THE YEAR 2020 AMENDING ARTICLE II "RECORDS RETENTION" OF CHAPTER 144 ENTITLED "RECORDS" OF THE CODE OF THE TOWN OF NEWBURGH

BE IT ENACTED by the Town Board of the Town of Newburgh as follows:

SECTION 1 - TITLE

This Local Law shall be referred to as "A Local Law Amending Article II entitled 'Records Retention' of Chapter 144 entitled 'Records' of the Code of the Town of Newburgh".

SECTION 2 - AMENDMENT

Article II entitled "Records Retention" of Chapter 144 entitled "Records" is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Article II Records Retention

§144-12 Schedule adopted.

Records Retention and Disposition Schedule for New York Local Government <u>Records MU-1 LGS-1</u>, issued pursuant to Article 57-A of the Arts and Cultural Affairs Law and containing legal minimum retention periods for municipal government records, is hereby adopted for use by all municipal officers in disposing of municipal government records listed therein.

§144-13 Disposal of records

In accordance with Article 57-A:

- A. Only those records will be disposed of that are described in Records Retention and Disposition Schedule for New York Local Government Records MU-1 LGS-1 after they have met the minimum retention period prescribed therein.
- B. Only those records will be disposed of that do not have sufficient administrative, fiscal, legal or historical value to merit retention beyond established time periods."

SECTION 3 - VALIDITY

The invalidity of any provision of this Local Law shall not affect the validity of any other provision of this Local Law that can be given effect without such invalid provision.

SECTION 4 - EFFECTIVE DATE

This Local Law shall take effect immediately when it is filed in the Office of the New York State Secretary of State in accordance with Section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.

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TOWN OF NEWBURGH INTRIODUCTORY LOCAL LAW NO. ___ OF THE YEAR 2020 SOLAR ENERGY SYSTEM PILOT LAW

BE IT ENACTED by the Town Board of the Town of Newburgh as follows:

§1. Title

This Local Law may be cited as the "Solar Energy System PILOT Law of the Town of Newburgh."

§2. Purpose

This Local Law is adopted to ensure that the benefits of the community's solar energy resource are available to the entire community, by promoting the installation of solar energy generating equipment through a payment-in-lieu-taxes (PILOT), granting reduced costs to system developers and energy consumers, and providing a revenue stream to the entire community.

§3. Authority

This Local Law is adopted under the authority granted by

- 1. Article IX of the New York State Constitution, §2(c)(8),
- 2. New York Statute of Local Governments, § 10 (5),
- 3. New York Municipal Home Rule Law, § 10 (1)(i) and (ii) and §10 (1)(a)(8), and
- 4. New York Real Property Tax Law § 487(9).

§4. Definitions

AC - alternating current

ANNUAL PAYMENT - the payment due under a PILOT Agreement entered into pursuant to Real Property Tax Law § 487(9). as the same may be amended, superseded or replaced.

ANNUAL PAYMENT DATE" - January 1st of each year.

CAPACITY - the manufacturer's nameplate capacity of the Solar Energy System as measured in kilowatts (kW) or megawatts (MW) AC.

OWNER - the owner of the property on which a Solar Energy System is located or installed, or their lessee, licensee or other person authorized to install and operate a Solar Energy System on the property.

RESIDENTIAL SOLAR ENERGY SYSTEM - a Solar Energy System with a nameplate generating capacity less than 50 kW AC in size, installed on the roof or the property of a residential dwelling, including multi-family dwellings, and designed to serve that dwelling or dwellings.

SBL NUMBER - Section-Block-Lot number on the County of Orange's Real Property Tax Maps.

SOLAR ENERGY EQUIPMENT - collectors, controls, energy storage devices, heat pumps and pumps, heat exchangers, windmills, and other materials, hardware or equipment necessary to the process by which solar radiation is (i) collected, (ii) converted into another form of energy such as thermal, electrical, mechanical or chemical, (iii) stored, (iv) protected from unnecessary dissipation and (v) distributed. It does not include pipes, controls, insulation or other equipment which are part of the normal heating, cooling, or insulation system of a building. It does include insulated glazing or insulation to the extent that such materials exceed the energy efficiency standards required by New York law.

SOLAR ENERGY SYSTEM - an arrangement or combination of Solar Energy Equipment designed to provide heating, cooling, hot water, or mechanical, chemical, or electrical energy by the collection of solar energy and its conversion, storage, protection and distribution.

§5. PILOT Required

A. The owner of a property on which a Solar Energy System is located or installed (including any improvement, reconstruction, or replacement thereof), shall enter into a PILOT Agreement with the Town consistent with the terms of this Local Law, except for

(1) Residential Solar Energy Systems;

(2) Solar Energy Systems with a capacity of 0.5 MW or less; and

(3) Solar Energy Systems that do not seek or qualify for an exemption from real property taxes pursuant to Real Property Tax Law § 487(4).

B. The Lessee or licensee of any owner of a property required to enter into a PILOT Agreement by this section, which owns or controls the Solar Energy System, may enter into the PILOT Agreement on behalf of the owner of the property.

C. Any owner or developer of a solar energy system that meets the requirements under RPTL §498(4) must notify the Town Supervisor via certified mail [or personal hand-delivery] of its intent to construct a solar energy system. Such notice must be sent to Town Supervisor, Town of Newburgh, 1496 Route 300, Newburgh, NY 12550.

D. Upon receipt of any notification from an owner or other person of intent to install a Solar Energy System, the Town Supervisor shall immediately, but in no case more than sixty days after receipt of the notification, the Town Supervisor or his designee shall notify the owner or other person by

certified mail or hand delivery of the mandatory requirement for a PILOT Agreement pursuant to the terms of this Local Law.

D. Nothing in this Local Law shall exempt any requirement for compliance with state and local codes for the installation of any solar energy equipment or a solar energy system, or authorize the installation of any solar energy equipment or a solar energy system. All solar energy systems must file a Real Property Tax Exemption application pursuant to Real Property Tax Law § 487 to receive a tax exemption.

E. The Annual Payments under the PILOT Agreement shall not exceed the amounts that would be otherwise payable but for the exemption under Real Property Tax §487 as the same may be amended, superseded or replaced.

§6. Contents of PILOT Agreements

A. Each PILOT Agreement entered into shall include

(1) Name and contact information of the Owner or other party authorized to act upon behalf of the Owner of the Solar Energy System.

(2) The SBL number for each parcel or portion of a parcel on which the Solar Energy System will be located.

(3) A requirement for fifteen successive annual payments, to be paid commencing on the first Annual Payment Date after the effective date of the Real Property Tax Exemption granted pursuant to Real Property Tax Law § 487.

(4) The Capacity of the Solar Energy System, and provision that if the Capacity is increased or increased as a result of a system upgrade, replacement, partial removal or retirement of Solar Energy Equipment, the annual payments shall be increased or decreased on a pro rata basis for the remaining years of the Agreement.

(5) That the parties agree that under the authority of RealProperty Tax Law § 487 the Solar Energy System shall be considered exempt from real property taxes for the fifteen-year life of the PILOT Agreement.

(6) That the PILOT Agreement may not be assigned without the prior written consent of the Town, which consent may not be unreasonably withheld if the Assignee has agreed in writing to accept all obligations of the Owner, except that the Owner may, with advance written notice to the Town but without prior consent, assign its payment obligations under the PILOT Agreement to an affiliate of the Owner or to any party who has provided or is providing financing to the Owner for or related to the Solar Energy System, and has agreed in writing to accept all payment obligations of the Owner.

(7) That a Notice of this Agreement may be recorded by the Owner at its expense, and that the Town shall cooperate in the execution of any Notices or Assignments with the Owner and its successors.

(8) That the Annual Payment shall be

i) For Solar Energy Systems with a Capacity greater than 0.5 MW, \$3,600.00 per MW of Capacity above 0.5 MW, pro-rated for fractional MW's.

ii) That the Annual Payment shall escalate three percent (3%) per year, starting with the second Annual Payment.

(9) That if the Annual Payment is not paid when due, that upon failure to cure within thirty days, the Town may cancel the PILOT Agreement without notice to the Owner, and the Solar Energy System shall thereafter be subject to taxation at its full assessed value.

(10) That in addition, if the Annual Payment is not paid when due, a late fee equal to five percent (5%) of the amount due shall be assessed on an annual basis.

§7. Severability

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Should any provision of this Local Law be declared by the courts to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of this Local Law as a whole or any part thereof other than the part so decided to be unconstitutional or invalid.

§8. Effective Date

This Local Law shall be effective upon its filing with the Secretary of State in accordance with the Municipal Home Rule Law, and shall apply to all solar energy systems constructed.

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PUBLIC EVENT AMBULANCE SERVICES AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT made as of December 15th, 2020 by and between the TOWN OF NEWBURGH EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES, INC. a not-for-profit corporation with offices at 97 South Plank Road, Newburgh, New York, (hereinafter called the "TONEMS") and the TOWN OF NEWBURGH, a municipal corporation of the State of New York, with offices at 1496 Route 300, Newburgh, New York, (hereinafter called the "Town").

WHEREAS, TONEMS is a New York State certified volunteer organization providing prehospital emergency medical treatment and ambulance transport of sick and injured persons found within the boundaries of the Town; and

WHEREAS, the Town sponsors certain public events attended by large numbers of people such as parades, community day and park concerts; and

WHREAS, the Town and TONEMS desire to enter into an agreement for the provision of standby ambulance, emergency medical and first aid services for public events sponsored by the Town.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises contained herein, it is agreed between the parties as follows:

1. TONEMS shall provide stand by ambulance service, pre-hospital emergency medical service and first-aid treatment service at up to five (5) public events in and sponsored by the Town during the one (1) year term of this Agreement. The Town shall provide reasonable advance written notice to the TONEMS of the scheduled date and rain date, time and location within the Town of such events. 2. In full consideration of such standby services, the Town shall pay the sum of FIVE THOUSAND AND N0/100 (\$5,000.00) DOLLARS to TONEMS within fourteen (14) days of its receipt of a fully executed counterpart of this Agreement. Nothing herein shall be construed to prohibit TONEMS from charging an injured or ill member of the public or such person's insurance carrier at TONEMS's normal rates for transportation from a Town sponsored public event in an ambulance. In no event shall TONEMS charge the Town a sum in addition to the consideration set forth herein for any such emergency service.

3. TONEMS shall provide all personnel required to accomplish the aforesaid standby event services. The personnel provided by TONEMS pursuant to this agreement shall be fully trained and supervised as required by law.

4. TONEMS shall keep such records of the work performed by TONEMS pursuant to this agreement as required by law and shall in all respects abide all of the laws, rules and regulations governing the providing the ambulance and related services described in this agreement.

5. Each party shall defend and save the other harmless from and shall indemnify the other for all judgments and awards, of every kind, for damages, costs, and expenses rendered against the other in all suits, actions, claims, and proceedings instituted against the other because of any injury, including death, to any person and/or any damage to any property caused or occasioned, directly or indirectly, by reason of any act or omission, whether or not negligent, on the part of the other, or their agents, servants, or any other person, engaged in any activity or work pursuant to the provisions of this Agreement. Each party shall notify the other of such suit, action, claim, or proceeding.

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6. This agreement shall have a term of one (1) year commencing on January 1, 2021. Unless at least sixty (60) days prior to the one year anniversary date, either party shall notify the other of its election not to renew, this Agreement shall automatically renew for an additional one (1) year term upon the same terms and conditions as set forth herein.

7. Neither party shall assign this agreement.

. 8. This Agreement is executed in, and shall be construed in accordance with the laws of the State of New York.

9. The invalidity or unenforceability of any provision(s) of this Agreement will not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provision(s).

10. This agreement shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the successors and assigns of the parties hereto.

11. This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and may only be modified in writing executed by both parties.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, this agreement has been signed by the Supervisor of the Town of Newburgh acting on behalf of the Town and in accordance with the resolution of the Town Board of the Town of Newburgh and by the TONEMS as authorized by its directors and its by-laws.
