- Draft, prepare, finalize and submit timely grant proposals which meet submission deadlines ; and
- Attend such other meetings as are required to accomplish the required work and to ensure that the grant is properly implemented to comply with the grant's terms.

The Town Supervisor will determine which Town Departments are to be your focus areas and advise you of same. The submission of grant proposals will be subject to Town Board approval. LAJ further agrees to use its best efforts to have the administrative costs associated with this agreement covered by the grant award.

The Town agrees to compensate LAJ at the rate of \$55.00 per hour for the above services. Billable hours will include all activities mentioned in the scope of service above, as well as telephone consultations. Travel time will not be billable unless the Town Supervisor specifically authorizes a trip out of the area in connection with a grant submission. Time will be rounded to the nearest quarter hour. The Town agrees to make a "retainer" prepayment to LAJ in the amount of \$2,000.00 upon your execution and return of this letter of agreement together with the enclosed signed and completed Voucher and W-9 forms. In the event the hours of service performed at the billable rate are less than the amount of the retainer and any other prepayment made by the Town to LAJ, LAJ agrees to refund the difference to the Town within 10 days of the expiration or termination date.

Stormwater Control Facility Maintenance Agreement

THIS AGREEMENT is made this _____ day of February, 2020 between and among the Town of Newburgh, having an address at 1496 Route 300, Newburgh, New York 12550 ("Municipality"); Webb Properties Inc., having an address at 800Auto Park Place Newburgh, New York 12550 (the "Property Owner") and GDPBJ, LLC, having an address at 145 Otterkill Road, P.O. Box 55, Mountainville, NY 10953 (the "Facility Owner") – (the Facility Owner and Property Owner together are referred to as "Owners")

Whereas, the Municipality and the Owners want to enter into an agreement to provide for the long term maintenance and continuation of stormwater control measures approved by the Municipality for the below named project; and

Whereas, the Facility Owner is the ground tenant pursuant to a certain Ground Lease dated July 1, 2019 of certain real property in the Town of Newburgh consisting of approximately +/- 9.95 acres more particularly described in Schedule "A" annexed hereto and made a part hereof (the "Property") and the Property Owner is fee owner of the Property; and

Whereas, the Municipality and the Facility Owner desire that the stormwater control measures be built in accordance with the approved project plans and thereafter be maintained, cleaned, repaired, replaced and continued in perpetuity in order to ensure optimum performance of the components; and

Whereas, the approved plans for the below named project incorporate additional property identified on the Orange County tax map as Town of Newburgh tax parcel 97-2-45 (the "Contributing Property") and the existing improvements thereon, and the stormwater control measures on the Property will additionally collect stormwater from a portion of the Contributing Property with all drainage facilities on the Contributing Property remaining the responsibility of the owner of the Contributing Property.

Now, therefore, the Municipality, Facility Owner and Property Owner agree as follows:

1. This agreement binds the Municipality and the Facility Owner, its successors and assigns to the maintenance provisions depicted in the approved project plans and Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan which are on file with the Municipality's Stormwater Management Officer.

2. The Facility Owner shall maintain, clean, repair, replace and continue the stormwater control measures depicted on the approved project plans for the Facility known as BJ's

Wholesale Club on and about the Property, as necessary to ensure optimum performance of the measures to design specifications. The stormwater control measures shall include, but shall not be limited to, the following: drainage ditches, swales, infiltrators, drop inlets, pipes, culverts, soil absorption devices, bioretention areas, stormwater filtration devices, and retention ponds and other stormwater practices identified in the Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) approved by the Municipality.

3. The Facility Owner shall be responsible for all expenses related to the maintenance of the stormwater control measures and shall establish a means for the collection and distribution of expenses among parties for any commonly owned facilities.

4. The Facility Owner shall provide for the periodic inspection of the stormwater control measures, not less than once a year, to determine the condition and integrity of the measures. Such inspection shall be performed by a Professional Engineer licensed by the State of New York. The inspecting engineer shall prepare and submit to the Municipality within 30 days of the inspection, a written report of the findings including recommendations for those actions necessary for the continuation of the stormwater control measures.

5. The Facility Owner shall not authorize, undertake or permit alteration, abandonment, modification or discontinuation of the stormwater control measures except in accordance with written approval of the Municipality. The obligations of the Facility Owner under paragraphs 2, 3, 4 and 6 of this Agreement shall toll upon the completion of the establishment of a drainage district of the Municipality and the acceptance of the dedication of the stormwater control measures by the Municipality. The tolling period shall end upon the discontinuance or dissolution of the municipal drainage district.

6. The Facility Owner shall undertake necessary maintenance, repairs and replacement of the stormwater control measures at the direction of the Municipality or in accordance with the recommendations of the inspecting engineer.

7. The Facility Owner shall provide to the Municipality within 30 days of the date of this agreement, such security for the maintenance and continuation of the stormwater control measures as the Municipality may have required in its approval in the form acceptable to the Town Engineer and Town Attorney (a bond, letter of credit or escrow account).

8. This agreement shall be recorded in the Office of the County Clerk, County of Orange and shall be included in any offering plan and/or prospectus or lease. All rights, title and privileges herein granted, including all benefits and burdens, shall run with the land and shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the parties hereto, their respective heirs, executors, administrators, successors, assigns and legal representatives. The Property Owner hereby consents to this Agreement and its recording and acknowledges and agrees that in the event the Facility Owner or its successors or assigns under the aforementioned Ground Lease is no longer

in possession of the Property, then at that time the duties and obligations of the Facility Owner shall become those of the fee owner of the Property.

9. If ever the Municipality determines that the Facility Owner has failed to construct or maintain the stormwater control measures in accordance with the project plans or has failed to undertake corrective action specified by the Municipality or by the inspecting engineer, the Municipality is authorized to undertake such steps as reasonably necessary for the preservation, continuation or maintenance of the stormwater control measures and to affix the expenses thereof as a lien against the property. The Facility Owner shall reimburse the Municipality for all costs and expenses, including reasonable attorneys' fees, incurred in enforcing this Agreement and curing a violation.

10. This agreement is effective February _____, 2020.

COMMENTS:

The landscape cost estimate for BJ's was reviewed. Unit costs for plant materials are low and the estimate for a three-year warranty for plant materials, \$9000, is low. The contractor should be made aware that plant materials will be inspected after planting. Sizes and species must be in accordance with approved plans and the latest edition of the American Standard for Nursery Stock or they will have to be replaced. After one year from the date of the approved landscape as recorded in the inspection report, the applicant can request a release of fifty percent of the total bond amount, not the warranty amount. A partial release will be recommended only if most plants survived and are in good condition and the landscape appears healthy and vigorous.

In accordance with comments listed above, I recommend the board approve a landscape security in the amount of \$122,213. The landscape inspection escrow amount for this project is \$4,000.

INTRIODUCTORY LOCAL LAW NO. __ OF THE YEAR 2020

A LOCAL LAW INCREASING THE SALARY OF TOWN CLERK FOR 2020 FISCAL YEAR

BE IT ENACTED by the Town Board of the Town of Newburgh, as follows:

Section 1. Legislative Intent and Authority.

The purpose of this Local Law is to increase the salary of the Town Clerk for the 2020 fiscal year. It is adopted pursuant to New York State Town Law §27 and Municipal Home Rule Law §10. In particular, Town Law §27 authorizes the Town Board to increase the salary of certain elected officials of the Town, including the Town Clerk, to an amount in excess of the amount specified in the notice of public hearing on the preliminary budget for not more than one fiscal year by adoption of a Local Law pursuant to the Municipal Home Rule Law.

Section 2. Increase in Salary.

The salary of the Town Clerk is hereby increased from \$55,603, the amount which was specified in the notice of hearing on the preliminary budget of the Town for the year 2020, to \$70,603, the increase to be distributed and paid evenly over the remainder of fiscal year following the effective date of this local law.

Section 3. Repealer; Supersession – All local laws and ordinances or parts of local laws or ordinances in conflict with any part of this Local law are hereby repealed.

Section 4. Severability.

If any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this Local Law or the application thereof to any person, firm or corporation, or circumstance, shall be adjusted by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, such order or judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this Local Law or in its application to the person, individual, firm or corporation or circumstance, directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment or order shall be rendered.

Section 5. Effective date.

This Local Law shall be subject to permissive referendum and shall not become operative or effective unless and until 45 days have elapsed after its adoption and no petition protesting against this Local Law has been filed with the Town Clerk or, if such a petition is filed, a proposition for the approval of this Local Law has been submitted and received the affirmative

vote of a majority of the voters voting thereon. If no petition is timely filed or if a petition is filed and this Local Law is approved, it shall take effect upon filing in the office of the New York Secretary of State.
