

Dear Chairman Scalzo and Zoning Board Members:

At the Planning Board's November 17, 2022 meeting, the Planning Board resolved to refer this application to the Zoning Board of Appeals for its consideration of the following area variances that are required for this two lot subdivision of lands located on Lakeside Road. The project proposes a two-lot subdivision of a 1.25 +/- acre parcel of property which fronts on Lakeside Road and Orange Lake. The parcel contains an existing single-family home with a proposal to create an additional lot for an additional single-family home. The project requires referral to the Zoning Board of Appeals as both resulting lots will are insufficient. The property is located in the Town's R2 zoning district. The following variances are required:

Lot 1: Minimum lot area - 40,000 square feet required, where 32,298 +/- square foot is provided. One side yard - 30 foot required where 18 feet is provided. Both side yards - 80 feet required where 53 feet is provided. Minimum lot width - 150 feet required, where 135 feet is provided. Impervious surface - 20% maximum allowed, proposed 31%.

Lot 2: Minimum lot area - 40,000 square feet required, 22,654 square feet is provided. Minimum lot width - 150 feet required, where 114 feet is provided.

The Planning Board has not declared its intent to serve as lead agency so that the Zoning Board of Appeals may consider and process this application without the need to wait for the Planning Board to conclude its SEQRA review.






