

I write to you on behalf of the Town of Newburgh Planning Board. The above referenced applicant appeared before the planning board during its meeting of July 21, 2016 requesting site plan approval to convert an existing framed garage on the premises into an office. There is also an existing singe family dwelling, another framed garage, a frame shed and a steel storage contained on the premises. The framed garage that is proposed to be converted into an office does not meet the required side yard setback of the code for an office. Additionally, the existing dwelling fails to meet the front yard setback of the code. Variances are therefore required.

The planning board has no particular matters to bring to your attention. Your review of this matter appears to be a Type II action under the New York State Environmental Quality Review Act.
