CHAIRMAN EWASUTYN: The final item this evening is Seriota, is it pronounced? It's an amended site plan located on Route 17K. It's in an IB Zone. It's being represented by Ross Winglovitz of Engineering Properties.

MR. WINGLOVITZ: Good evening. We were here in front of you last month regarding the Seriota Site Plan for reuse of the existing building on Cochecton Avenue and 17K.

12 We resubmitted the plans on the 7th. I 13 know there was a timeframe for our referral. I 14 don't know if that's lapsed from when the 15 referral was made.

16 We responded to the comments by adding 17 the curbing to the road. We have added a portion 18 of the stonewall. My client was very sensitive 19 to the cost he's incurring with the project, 20 paving the driveway, the significant landscaping 21 plan, the potential for a sprinkler system. So I 22 tried to get him to run the stonewall along the 23 whole front of the building -- the whole frontage 24 of the property but he was hesitant to do that 25 because of the cost. We provided a stonewall on

either corner of the berm. That's going to be basically screening of the building from the road.

Other than that, I don't think there was anything significant. Some clean-up as far as map notes and grading of the berm.

We're here to answer any questions you may have.

That's been cleaned up for 8 the lot consolidation. 9 Concrete curbing has been shown 10 throughout the site, along with paving. Drop 11 curbs have been provided for drainage control on 12 those, so there's no closed pipe drainage system needed. 13 14 Map note 9 has been revised according 15 to the zoning code for three vehicles to be 16 stored outside for repair. The maximum of three. 17 The landscape plan, as Ross just 18 discussed, fieldstone accents have been provided 19 on either side of the berm. The Board did 20 discuss that at work session and felt those were 21 appropriate and fit in with the character of the 2.2 neighborhood there. The only outstanding item is whether a 23 public hearing is going to be held or not. 24 MR. DONNELLY: You voted to waive it at 25
