

a) THE VARIANCE WILL NOT PRODUCE AN UNDESIREABLE CHANGE IN THE CHARACTER OF THE NEIGHBORHOOD OR A DETRIMENT TO NEARBY PROPERTIES BECAUSE:

Our proposed single family residence is located in the center portion of our 23.5 acre tree farm and will be a minimum of 156' from any lot line, minimizing any visual impact on neighboring properties. The private garage is intended for the interior storage of our large 5th wheel RV and three personal vehicles, which is intended by the Code. The interior storage would not produce any undesirable change in the character of the neighborhood, and will also reduce the visual impact on adjoining properties.

b) THE BENEFIT SOUGHT BY THE APPLICANT CAN NOT BE ACHIEVED BY SOME METHOD, FEASIBLE FOR THE APPLICANT TO PURSUE, OTHER THAN AN AREA VARIANCE, BECAUSE:

The applicant is seeking to protect from the weather and maintain a large 5th wheel RV, farm tractors, implements, and three personal vehicles. A separate building to facilitate such would be allowed by zoning, but is not economically feasible or energy efficient. A separate building would also more likely has an undesirable change to the neighborhood character.

c) THE REQUESTED AREA VARIANCE IS NOT SUBSTANTIAL BECAUSE:

We are seeking to store only four vehicles in the private garage, which is expressly permitted under the code. One of these vehicles is larger than the typical automobile. Even if it is determined that a variance is required, it is *de minimis*.

d) THE PROPOSED VARIANCE WILL NOT HAVE AN ADVERSE EFFECT OR IMPACT ON THE PHYSICAL OR ENVIRONMENTAL CONDITIONS IN THE NEIGHBORHOOD OR DISTRICT BECAUSE:

The site of our proposed single family residence in an AR zone, in Agricultural District 1. The proposed residence is shielded by existing trees, meets or exceeds current energy code requirements, and will ultimately have a smaller carbon footprint than the average older single family residence.

e) THE HARDSHIP HAS NOT BEEN SELF CREATED BECAUSE:

We designed a structure which, in our interpretation, did not require a variance. In a notice dated April 14, 2020, Joseph Mattina denied our permit and referred us to the Zoning Board of Appeals. In any case, according to Section 267-b(3)(b)(5), whether the difficulty is self-created shall not preclude the granting of the variance.
