Orange County is an adjoining property owner to the north. The lot line change will result in what's identified as lot 2 becoming a land locked parcel, losing its access to North Plank Road. Mike Donnelly's comments regarding this situation and County ownership should be addressed.
- 2. No improvements exist on either of the lots, such that no zoning bulk issues exist.
- **3.** A 50 ft. right of way is proposed to be extinguished. Information pertaining to extinguishment of the right of way should be provided for Mike Donnelly's office to review.


