Susan D Carroll, being duly sworn, deposes and says the following to be true:

That I reside at, and own 2122 Route 300, Wallkill, New York 12589, which is located in the Town of Newburgh, County of Orange, State of New York. I have received a notice that a hearing that will occur on February 23, 2017 that involves the interpretation of a Use Variance granted to William C. Conklin ("Conklin") in March 1982 (the "Use Variance"). I am the Trustee for the Walter A Carroll Sr. Irrevocable Trust, which owns a one-half interest inSBL(3-1-20) 2116 Route 300 and borders 2102 Partners LLC SBL(3-1-21.31) premises located at 2102 Route 300 along its entire westerly border. I also am here tonight for my property that is also listed as SBL(3-1-19) 2116 Route 300 for which I have resided the last 27 years. I have attached a tax map and highlighted my families' two parcels that total 8 acres. My family has owned SBL(3-1-20) 2116 Route 300 continuously for 70 years. This application is extremely important to me because if the Board interprets the Use Variance so as to permit the addition of the new hydro-excavation business to continue at 2102 Route 300 Wallkill, NY (the subject premises) it would affect my properties adversely inasmuch as my families property SBL(3-1-20) borders this new business. I am providing this sworn Affidavit to the Board, to be entered into the record, as my testimony before the Zoning Board of Appeals. For the reasons to follow, the Board should hold that the current hydro-excavation business that is being operated on the former premises of Conklin does not fall within the Use Variance.

I have attached two printouts that show WCC Tank Technology and Hydrovac Excavation Inc. have two distinctly separate websites. WCC Tank Technology's website shows that "Ira Conklin III started Hydrovac Excavating in 2003 and it is a company he still owns and runs today." This clearly shows that it is a company separate of WCC Tank Technology and formed well after the granting of the original Use Variance for WCC Tank Technology in 1982. This clearly shows that the Hydrovac Excavation business could not have been contemplated by the ZBA in 1982 when it granted the use variance. I also wish to attach a copy of information that I have obtained that shows this company's prior address was 5288 Route 9W; Newburgh, NY 12550. Sometime between July 2015 to August 2015, this new business showed up at 2102 Route 300 Wallkill, NY and began operating its unapproved operation.

This new business has nothing to do with tank lining, rather it is an excavation business which dumps the dirt it collects off site on the premises. To be sure, this new business is not a small business like the original tank lining business that Conklin operated, but a heavy commercial industrial business that operates at all hours and days. They have also created a retention pond on the west side of the subject property that borders my family's property. To the best of my knowledge this was made without approvals or oversight of the Town of Newburgh's Storm Water Management Regulations. They have dumped thousands of yards of dirt and clear cut the entire property, this has significantly changed the grade and rural appearance of the subject premises. This grade prevents the natural runoff of water as natural springs use to go through the subject property. Water now backs up on my property and the Perry property during heavy rains and creates a flooding condition on our properties that never previously existed. Complaints about the operation have been made by numerous residents about the many issues that are violating the Town Code by this new business with no action by the Town Code Compliance Office. I believe as many of my neighbors that this new business has nothing to do with tank lining and it does not fall under the original Use Variance. The websites for these business certainly show that they do completely different operations. It is for these reasons that I am asking the Zoning Board of Appeals after hearing all the testimony from the residents to find that these are two separate businesses and the 1982 Use Variance never intended to include anything else but Tank Lining.
