Sure. This is part of the 2 MR. HINES: upgrades to Chadwick in support of the Delaware 3 shutdown. The existing control system is dated 4 and is in need of upgrade. It has to do with the 5 ability to connect the trailer-mounted filter б that's going to come in as a resiliency 7 component. GHD are the engineers that currently 8 do the SCADA and programmable logic at the 9 Delaware filter plant. There will be identical 10 equipment being placed at the Chadwick plant to 11 coordinate the electronics of that plant, 12 coordinated with your system, co-communicating 13 with your tanks and just generally running your 14 whole system. GHD does that at your Delaware 15 plant now and they are the proposed (technical 16 interruption). 17

You had already moved \$200,000 to an 18 account to account for that last year. 19 The balance of the costs will come out of this year's 20 21 budget. It's an upgrade to the plant and coordinated with that resilency project that you 22 have for when the Delaware Aqueduct is shutdown. 23 24 SUPERVISOR PIAQUADIO: Very good, Pat. Thank you. 25
