

	The garage addition will not look out of scale with other houses in the neighborhood. The addition is also in character with the existing architecture and not a detriment. The garage will have the exact same aesthetics as current house on property.
b)	THE BENEFIT SOUGHT BY THE APPLICANT CAN NOT BE ACHIEVED BY SOME METHOD, FEASIBLE FOR THE APPLICANT TO PURSUE, OTHER THAN AN AREA VARIANCE, BECAUSE: The garage addition can only be added to this area of the property. The proposed width
	of the addition is standard for a two car garage - 24'-0". There is a 10'-0" gap between the existing house and new garage.
